

TOP SECTION Arts Award Mission

These questions will help you investigate art. Choose at least 3 questions for each artwork you investigate.

Draw or write your answers on scrap paper when you

are in the galleries.

MATERIALS

Can you find out what <u>materials</u> the artist has used to make their artwork? Wood? Canvas? Ceramic? Paper? Paint? A mixture of materials?



What <u>textures</u> can you see in the artwork you're looking at? Smooth? Shiny? Rough? If you're not sure about this, <u>imagine</u> how the artwork might feel if you touched it. ASK BEFORE ACTUALLY TOUCHING THE ARTWORK THOUGH! Some artworks might have more than one texture.

COLOUR

Which <u>colours</u> did you notice first when you looked at the image? <u>Why</u> do you think you noticed those colours first? Which colours did you notice when you looked a bit more closely?

MESSAGE

Why do you think the artist made this image?
For fun? To make you think about something?
To impress you? To make you feel an emotion such as calm, excited, or angry?

YOUR FAVOURTTE THING

What is your favourite thing about the artwork you're looking at?

COMPARE WITH ANOTHER ARTWORK

Are there any similarities or difference between this artwork and other artworks in your pathway?
